Hanging wires fixed above the cottage fence. Stakes at horseshoe pit capped. Sunken pavers in the walkway from Florido Parking lot to Clubhouse courtyard were raised by the DPW (County) but were not done using the 'appropriately' licensed contractor. Generator gate was closed off by the DPW (County).

La Selva Tree came and finished work on Ian-Adjacent Park's large Cypress and finished trimming risky limbs, came and 'unloaded' a side of the tree that had more branches than the other, and minimized risk of limbs shearing off during wind events.

8. New Business

DM Serrano repaired old picnic benches with new wood and repainted. Cleaned graffiti off trees at bluff.

Basketball Courts and Pole Pads: New Pole Pads were put on the two metal poles for added safety for court users. Serrano purchased, assembled, and placed ADA benches in Batchelor's Park and Courtyard. Replaced one broken white plastic bench and one dilapidated, rusted metal bench.

Swing-Set (Bachelor's Playground) in need of repairs. The two posts that hold up the swing-set, on the east side of the swing-set, are about 33% worn through. We need to come up with a fix here soon.

- (a) There are two 45° cut pieces of wood holding up the swing-set but those are just temporary fixes and have outlived their functional lives
- (b) The Swings are a safety hazard
